The Kimberley Quest II carries three excursion tenders and a shaded fast boat, so days are filled with a myriad of activities both on and off land, exploring the spectacular region with your very own local guide, who has extensive knowledge of the Kimberley coastline. During your cruise you are free to do as much or as little as you wish.





ONBOARD EXPERIENCE



Each cabin includes its own large private ensuite with hair dryer, individual air-conditioning, personal mini-fridge and viewing window. Storage in your cabin consists of a closet with hangers, a cupboard, and a space for stowage underneath your bed. Cabins are serviced daily.

FLY BRIDGE CABIN

Our exclusive flybridge cabin is the only guest cabin on the top deck and features a queen size walk-around bed, as well as a large viewing window. This is our most luxurious cabin and provides the ultimate in onboard comfort.



SUPERIOR CABINS

Our superior cabins are located on the main deck and feature a queen size bed and large viewing windows. This option is well suited to guests who wish to add a little indulgence to their onboard stay.

DOUBLE CABINS










21 DAY BEYOND ADVENTURE



This exploration cruise starts from Darwin capturing the spectacular Kimberley waterfall season allowing extra time to explore the vast Kimberley coastline. Cruise the steep gorges and experience the sheer power of the long drop waterfalls in the north, visit fascinating historical sites of WWII, ancient rock art sites and lost cities. You will fish for the elusive Barramundi and many other fish species as well as enjoy refreshing dips in pristine waterholes. As you head south you will visit many renowned icons of the Kimberley including King Cascade, Montgomery Reef and the famous Horizontal Falls. *Operates March to April. Starts Darwin, ends Broome*



14 DAY ULTIMATE QUEST

This ultimate wilderness cruise along the whole of the Kimberley coast between Broome and Wyndham really does have it all! Witness amazing Kimberley icons such as the King George Falls, Prince Regent River, Montgomery Reef and the Horizontal Falls. Enjoy refreshing swims in freshwater holes, explore historical Aboriginal art sites, view majestic gorges and fish for the prized Barramundi and many other species. This cruise operates just after the wet season when the waterfalls are spectacular!

Operates March to June. Runs between Broome and Kununurra in both directions.



10 DAY ADVENTURE QUEST

The '10 day Adventure Quest' is an extensive exploration of the southern Kimberley, visiting many unknown sights, rarely visited islands, inlets and 'secret spots'. Enjoy pristine beaches, secluded fresh water swimming holes, ancient Aboriginal art sites, fishing for Barramundi and many more fish species. This itinerary includes visiting icons such as the Horizontal Falls, Montgomery Reef and King Cascade to name a few.



8 DAY SOUTHERN QUEST



Many icons of the Kimberley can be found in the stunning southern region including the Horizontal Falls, Montgomery Reef and King Cascade. This area is also prolific with islands, whirlpools, inlets and pockets of rainforest, home to many species of birds and other wildlife. You will enjoy a helicopter flight over the Mitchell Falls, as well as exploring a land of extraordinary contrast and colour, rich in history, ancient Aboriginal rock art and breathtaking scenery. *Operates June to October. Starts Broome, ends Broome. Includes scenic flight transfer and helicopter flight.*

8 DAY NORTHERN QUEST

Exploring between Wyndham and the Mitchell River, this cruise is renowned for its massive gorges and river systems, extensive waterfalls,WorldWar II relics and incredible Gwion Gwion rock art sites.You will visit Kimberley icons such as the King George Falls, Berkeley River, Drysdale River and many more. Enjoy refreshing swims in freshwater holes, explore historical sites and fish for the elusive Barramundi.This quest also includes a helicopter flight over the Mitchell Falls and operates just after the wet season when the waterfalls are spectacular!

Operates April to May. Runs between Broome and Kununurra in both directions. Includes scenic flight transfer and helicopter flight.

4 DAY TASTE OF THE KIMBERLEY






FISHING EXPEDITIONS



EXCLUSIVE PRIVATE CHARTERS



TENDER EXCURSIONS



Every onshore expedition consists of an interesting and sometimes exhilarating tender excursion. View mangrove habitats, spot crocodiles basking on the mudflats, bird watch, fish, and experience the natural beauty of the Kimberley. Sightseeing from the comfort and safety of the Kimberley Quest II excursion vessels, which consist of three 5 metre tenders and the 11 metre shaded Quest Express.



Throughout your cruise you will visit places of historical, cultural and scenic interest, including the 1820 Mermaid boab tree, 1864 Camden Harbour settlement, King Cascade and many other exciting areas where there is the option to walk and explore with your guides. Treks vary in difficulty and your crew will advise you accordingly.

ANCIENT ROCK ART



Some of the best Wandjina and Gwion Gwion (or Bradshaw) art sites can be viewed throughout your cruise. Wandjina art can be seen along the whole of the Kimberley coastline whilst the enigmatic Gwion Gwion art is located predominantly in the northern region. Be amazed by the different epochs and art styles and learn the ancient stories behind them.



FISHING



Our fishing activities have no rigid daily schedule, the captain and guides decide what areas will offer the best opportunities on each day. It is important to us that sustainable fishing is practiced, with only enough fish for the table kept. Mangrove Jack, Threadfin Salmon, Spanish Mackerel and Queenfish are among the fish species caught, not forgetting the prized Barramundi!



Swimming is an integral part of the cruise itinerary. Wherever possible our guides plan expeditions which include an opportunity to cool off in pristine picturesque spring-fed waterholes. All swimming is conducted in safe surroundings, well away from estuarine crocodile habitats.

WHALES AND MARINE LIFE



Majestic Humpback Whales train their newborn calves in the warm Kimberley waters from July through to September. These magnificent mammals can often be seen frolicking from the bow of the Kimberley Quest II, making for fantastic photographic opportunities. Also view an abundance of other marine life including the Australian snubfin dolphin, dugongs, turtles and sea snakes in their natural habitat.



QUEST CUISINE



Cuisine on board the *Kimberley Quest II* is simply delicious. All meals are prepared by our talented chef in the fully equipped open galley, offering an array of fresh fish, seafood, the highest quality meats, freshly baked breads and some of the best local produce.
